- Wash away mesh stabilizer
- Quilter's Batting (high-loft batting)
- ½ yd of Craft Fuse 808 Pellon
- ¼ yd of fabric for the inside of the Carriage
- ¼ yd of fabric for the outside of the Carriage
- Scraps of fabric for the doors
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- 80/12 or 90/14 sharp embroidery and sewing needles
- Embroidery thread
- [Embroidery snips](#)
- X-Acto blade
- 5/16" hollow hole punch and hammer
- High Temperature Hot Glue
- [Charming Carriage Wheel Kit](#) (Includes 4 wheels, 2 axels, 4 axel caps, 4beads, and Velcro)

Note: If you don't want to purchase the Charming Carriage Wheel Kit, you will need:

- 1—1" piece of Velcro
- 4—8mm round beads for the door handles
- 4—2½" wheels (¼" thick)
- 2—3½" pieces of ¼" dowels
- 4—9/16" axel caps with ¼" hole

8" Long x 6" Tall x 3" Wide
