- Wash away mesh stabilizer
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- ⊗ 80/12 sharp embroidery needles and regular needles
- Embroidery thread, sewing thread, and bobbin thread
- Embroidery nips (or small scissors)
- Mini Anorak Setting Tools
- 80/12 or 90/14 sharp embroidery needles and regular needles
- Embroidery thread
- Embroidery nips
- X-Acto blade

### Fabric List—Bridge

- 1 vd Craft Fuse Pellon 808
- ⊕ 1 12" x 18" sheet of 2mm embroidery foam (optional)

## FABRIC LIST—ROUNDHOUSES

- Cut away mesh stabilizer

- 3 2mm Embroidery Foam
- Hot Glue
- Mini Anorak Snaps (5 per roundhouse, 1 per turntable)

- 1 bead for the door handle
- 4 Mini Anorak Snaps (or Velcro)

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
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# SUPPLY LIST

- Cut away mesh stabilizer
- ® Cotton fabric (pre-shrunk, ironed, and starched) for each quilt square
- Fabric scraps (pre-shrunk and ironed) for the appliqués
- Quilter's batting
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- ⊗ 80/12 sharp embroidery needles and regular needles
- Embroidery thread, sewing thread, and bobbin thread
- Embroidery nips (or small scissors)



- Base Fabric (Green) for a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: 5/8 yd
  - 5x5 Squares: 7/8 yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 1yd
- Border Fabric (Blue) for a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd
  - 5x5 Squares: <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 1yd
- Fat quarters or stash fabric for the appliqué trains
- Fabric for the green sashing for a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd
  - 5x5 Squares: 3/8 yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 3/8 yd
- Solution Fabric for the blue sashing for a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: \( \frac{1}{8} \) yd
  - 5x5 Squares: 1/8 yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 1/4 yd
- Fabric for the back of a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: 1 yd
  - 5x5 Squares: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 3 yd (You will need to piece this back. If you can find quilt back fabric, you will only need 11/3 yd.)
- Fabric for the binding for a quilt made from:
  - 4x4 Squares: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yd
  - 5x5 Squares: 1/3 yd
  - 6x6 Squares: 3/8 yd



#### Finished Quilt Sizes

(Width x Length) For a quilt made from:

4x4 Squares: About 31" x 35" 5x5 Squares: About 38½" x 44"

6x6 Squares: About 44½" x 51"
