

BEDTIME RAIL LINE QUILT HOOP SIZES: 4x4, 5x5, AND 6x6

SUPPLY LIST

- Cut away mesh stabilizer
- Water soluble mesh stabilizer
- Cotton fabric (pre-shrunk, ironed, and starched) for each quilt square
- Fabric scraps (pre-shrunk and ironed) for the appliqués
- Quilter's batting
- Winyl oilcloth (for the railroad signs)
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- ⊗ 80/12 sharp embroidery needles and regular needles
- Embroidery thread, sewing thread, and bobbin thread
- Embroidery nips (or small scissors)
- Temporary Spray Adhesive
- 2mm Embroidery Foam
- Quick Grip Glue

FABRIC LIST FOR THE A QUILT WITHOUT ACCESSORIES

- Base Fabric (Green) for a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: 1\(^1/8\) yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 1½ yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 21/4 yd
- Fat quarters or stash fabric for the lake, ponds, and Railroad Crossing Sign
- Second Fabric For Sashing for a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: ½ yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 3/8 yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 5/8 yd
- Fabric for the back of a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: 1 yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 1½ yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 3¼ yd (You will need to piece this back. If you can find quilt back fabric, you will only need 1⅓ yd.)
- Second Fabric Fabric
 - 4x4 Squares: 1/4 vd
 - 5x5 Squares: ¹/₃ yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 3/8 yd

Finished Quilt Sizes

(Width x Length) For a quilt made from:

4x4 Squares: About 31" x 40" 5x5 Squares: About 38½" x 49.5" 6x6 Squares: About 44½" x 57¼"

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
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FABRIC LIST FOR THE A QUILT WITH ACCESSORIES

- Base Fabric (Green) for a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: 11/4 yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 1²/₃ yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 21/3 yd
- Second Fabric Fabric
 - 4x4 Squares: ½ yd
 - 5x5 Squares: \(\frac{5}{8} \) yd
 - 6x6 Squares: ²/₃ yd
- Solution Fabric for the back of a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: 11/4 yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 17/8 yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 2½ yd (You will need to piece this back. If you can find quilt back fabric, you will only need 1⅓ yd.)
- Fabric for the binding for a quilt made from:
 - 4x4 Squares: 1/4 yd
 - 5x5 Squares: 1/3 yd
 - 6x6 Squares: 3/8 yd

4x4 Squares: About 31" x 44" 5x5 Squares: About 38½" x 55" 6x6 Squares: About 44½" x 63½"
