

SUPPLY LIST for the 4x4 Book and Quilt

General Supplies:

- Tear-away or cut-away stabilizer
- ½ yd in several colors of felt, flannel, fleece, suede - any fabric that won't fray for each of the pages, pockets, puzzle, and accessories. (You will have a lot left over, but it needs to be wide enough to hoop.)
- Fabric scraps that will not fray for the appliqués
- 11 squares of scrap fabric that measure 1½"x1½" (These will not show in the finished book/quilt, so color doesn't matter.)
- Size 80/12 sharp embroidery needles
- Bobbin thread
- Embroidery thread
- Small embroidery nips
- Fray Check
- Spray Adhesive (I recommend Dritz Spray Adhesive for this project)
- X-Acto knife (A MUST!)
- Rotary cutter with regular blade and pinking blade (optional)
- Tapestry needle for ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- Hot glue or fabric glue (optional)

Special Supplies for each page:

Bunny Puzzle Pages:

- Felt for puzzle
- Steam-A-Seam2 double-sided fusible web
- Fabric for back of puzzle
- Ribbon: If you want to add a beaded handle, use ⅝" ribbon. If you will not be adding beads, use ⅝" or ¼" ribbon.
One Color Weaving: 2¼ yds ribbon
Two Color Weaving: 1½ yd each of contrasting ribbon
- Beads with a large enough hole for a tapestry needle (optional)

Chicks in the Egg Pages:

- ⅔ yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper

Concentration Game Pages:

- ⅔ yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper
- 5 matching pieces of 3"x3" patterned fabric

Easter Basket Pages:

- 1 yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon

Lamb Pages:

- ⅓ yd of ½" (or smaller) ribbon

Front and Back Covers:

- Small pom pom (for bunny tail!)

Front and Back Covers:

- 1—2"x4" piece of patterned fabric

Easter Quiet Book Assembly

- 3¼ yd of 30 mm ric-rac (optional)
- 18—¼" grommets
- 1—14mm (½") or smaller button for tab
- 3/16" hole punch
- 1¼ yd of ½" or ⅝" ribbon OR 3—1" book rings
- Hammer

Easter Quilt Assembly

- 1¼ yds of 60" wide chenille or other soft fabric
- 10 yds of yellow 30mm red ric-rac or other trim (optional)
- 4 yds of green ric-rac or other trim (optional)

SUPPLY LIST for the 5x7 Book and Quilt

General Supplies:

- Tear-away or cut-away stabilizer
- ½ yd in several colors of felt, flannel, fleece, suede - any fabric that won't fray for each of the pages, pockets, puzzle, and accessories. (You will have a lot left over, but it needs to be wide enough to hoop.)
- Fabric scraps that will not fray for the appliqués
- 18 squares of scrap fabric that measure 1½"x1½" (These will not show in the finished book/quilt, so color doesn't matter.)
- Size 80/12 sharp embroidery needles
- Bobbin thread
- Embroidery thread
- Small embroidery nips
- Fray Check
- Spray Adhesive (I recommend Dritz Spray Adhesive for this project)
- X-Acto knife (A MUST!)
- Rotary cutter with regular blade and pinking blade (optional)
- Tapestry needle for ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- Hot glue or fabric glue (optional)

Special Supplies for each page:

Bunny Puzzle Pages:

- Felt for puzzle
- Steam-A-Seam2 double-sided fusible web
- Fabric for back of puzzle
- Ribbon: If you want to add a beaded handle, use ⅝" ribbon. If you will not be adding beads, use ⅝" or ¼" ribbon.
One Color Weaving: 2¼ yds ribbon
Two Color Weaving: 1⅓ yd each of contrasting ribbon
- Beads with a large enough hole for a tapestry needle (optional)

Chicks in the Egg Pages:

- 1¼ yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper

Concentration Game Pages:

- 1¼ yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon
- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper
- 5 matching pieces of 4"x4" patterned fabric

Easter Basket Pages:

- 1¼ yd of ¼" or ⅝" ribbon

Lamb Pages:

- ⅓ yd of ½" (or smaller) ribbon

Front and Back Covers:

- Small pom pom (for bunny tail!)

Front and Back Covers:

- 1—2"x4" piece of patterned fabric

Easter Quiet Book Assembly

- 4 yd of ric rac or other trim (optional)
- 18 to 30—¼" grommets
- 1—14mm (½") or smaller button for tab
- 3/16" hole punch
- 1½ yd of ½" or ⅝" ribbon OR 5—1" book rings
- Hammer

Easter Quilt Assembly

- 1¾ yds of 60" wide chenille or other soft fabric
- 12 yds of 30mm ric-rac or other trim (optional)
- 5 yds of pom pom trim or other trim (optional)
