

SUPPLY LIST

- 1 3½" x 14" piece of fabric for the back of the bonnet—I used batiste
- 1 2" x 22" piece of fabric for the ruffle—I used batiste
- 1 1½" x 16" piece of fabric for the insertion lace appliqué— I used batiste
- 1 3" x 16" piece of English Cotton Netting for the insertion lace appliqué
- 1 1" x 44" binding (bonnet ties)
- 22" of lace
- 22" of ½" ribbon
- Wash away mesh stabilizer
- Spray Starch
- 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray
- Embroidery thread
- Wash Away Fabric Pen
- 60 wt or higher weight thread
- Wash away fabric pen
- 5x7 hoop or a 14" hoop if you have one
