

## SUPPLY LIST

- Cut away mesh stabilizer
- Soft tear away stabilizer
- § 505 Adhesive Spray
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- 80/12 or 90/14 sharp embroidery and sewing needles
- Embroidery thread, sewing thread, and bobbin thread
- Embroidery nips (or small scissors)
- 3/4" bias tape maker tip OR a Simplicity Bias Tape Maker with a 3/4" tip (if you have one)
- Temporary Basting Glue
- ⊕ 1—15" x 15" Pillow Form for each pillow
- ⊕ 1—16" or longer zipper for each pillow
- ⊕ 12/32" or 3/8" filler cord for the bag handles

## FABRIC LIST

## FOR EACH PLACEMAT

- ⊕ ¼ yd of 93" wide high loft quilter's batting

- $\otimes$  ½ yd of fabric for the straight sashing (5x7 set only)
- ½ yd of fabric for the bias sashing (you'll have lots left over)
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yd of fabric for the back (you can get three backs
  out of this piece of fabric)

#### FOR EACH PILLOW

- ⊕ ⅓ yd of fabric for each pillow back

## FOR EACH BAG

- ⊕ ½ yd of fabric for each pair of handles
