



# HALLOWEEN QUIET BOOK

HOOP SIZES: 4X4 AND 5X7

## HALLOWEEN QUIET BOOK—4X4

- If you are making a book, the base fabric should be felt, fleece, or a fabric that does not fray (if you are making a quilt, you can use any fabric for the base pages). You can also use fabric backed with Pellon for the book.
- Any fabric can be used for the appliqués.

## SUPPLY LIST:

### General Supplies:

- Tear away or cut away stabilizer
- Wash away mesh stabilizer
- ½ yd in several colors of felt, flannel, fleece, suede - any fabric that won't fray for each of the pages, pockets, puzzle, and accessories. (You will have a lot left over, but it needs to be wide enough to hoop.)
- Fabric scraps for the appliqués
- Size 80/12 sharp embroidery needles
- Bobbin thread
- Embroidery thread
- Small embroidery nips
- Fray Check
- Scotch Tape
- X-Acto knife (A MUST!)
- Rotary cutter with regular blade and pinking blade (optional)
- Tapestry needle for ¼" or ⅛" ribbon

### Special Supplies for each page:

#### Jack-O-Lantern Face Pages

- ⅔ yd of ¼" or ⅛" ribbon
- 3 small snaps
- 3 baby buttons

#### Memory Game Pages:

- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper (an invisible or regular zipper can be used)
- 5"x5" scrap of fabric



#### Tic-Tac-Toe Pages:

- 3"x5" scrap of fabric

#### Owl Puzzle Pages:

- ⅓ yd of ¼" or ⅛" ribbon
- 12 mm button
- 5"x5" scrap of fabric
- Felt for puzzle
- Steam-A-Seam2 double-sided fusible web
- Fabric for back of puzzle

#### Trick or Treat Pages:

- 5"x5" scrap of fabric

#### Halloween Quiet Book Assembly

- 18—¼" grommets
- 1—14mm (½") or smaller button for tab
- ¼" hole punch
- 3—1" book rings
- Hammer

#### Halloween Quilt Assembly

- 1¼ yds of 60" wide chenille or other soft fabric
- 4 yds of rickrack or other trim (optional)

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## HALLOWEEN QUIET BOOK—5x7

- If you are making a book, the base fabric should be felt, fleece, or a fabric that does not fray (if you are making a quilt, you can use any fabric for the base pages). You can also use fabric backed with pellon for the book.
- Any fabric can be used for the appliqués.

### SUPPLY LIST:

#### General Supplies:

- Tear away or cut away stabilizer
- Wash away mesh stabilizer
- ½ yd in several colors of felt, flannel, fleece, suede - any fabric that won't fray for each of the pages, pockets, puzzle, and accessories. (You will have a lot left over, but it needs to be wide enough to hoop.)

#### Special Supplies for each page:

##### Jack-O-Lantern Face Pages

- 1 yd of ¼" or ⅛" ribbon
- 3 small snaps
- 3 baby buttons

##### Memory Game Pages:

- 7" Nylon or Polyester Zipper (an invisible or regular zipper can be used)
- 6"x8" scrap of fabric

##### Tic-Tac-Toe Pages:

- 4"x6" scrap of fabric

##### Owl Puzzle Pages:

- ½ yd of ¼" or ⅛" ribbon
- 12 mm button
- 6"x8" scrap of fabric
- Felt for puzzle
- Steam-A-Seam2 double-sided fusible web
- Fabric for back of puzzle

#### Trick or Treat Pages:

- 6"x6" scrap of fabric

#### Halloween Quiet Book Assembly

- 30—¼" grommets
- 1—14mm (½") or smaller button for tab
- 3/16" hole punch
- Hammer
- 5—1" book rings

#### Halloween Quilt Assembly

- 1¾ yds of 60" wide chenille or other soft fabric
- 5 yds of pom pom trim or other trim (optional)
