Supply List

- Felt the crust, frosting, piping, carrots, carrot tops, and bunny cake topper (I like felt by the yard, but 9" x 12" sheets of felt will work, too)
- 2 2³/₄" x 3³/₄" or larger
 Cellulose sponges in orange or yellow. You can find these at the dollar stores, Walmart, etc.
- Cut away mesh stabilizer (for the Bunny Topper)
- Wash away mesh stabilizer (for the Cake Platter and Plate)
- Sharp shears
- Little snips to cut thread
- Hand sewing needles and thread for the carrots
- Polyfill Stuffing
- Hot glue (or whatever quickdrying, permanent fabric glue you prefer)
- Bakery Scented or Carrot Cake Essential Oils (Optional)
- Pom poms for the bunny tails and cake decorations (optional)
- Pinking or scalloped scissors (optional)
- Velcro (optional)
