

## Supply List:

- Sheer cut away mesh stabilizer
- Ruler and Rotary cutter
- 90/14 sharp embroidery needles
- Embroidery and bobbin thread
- [Embroidery snips](#)
- ¼ yd of main fabric
- ¼ yd of alternate fabric (optional)
- ¼ yd of lining fabric
- ¼ yd of [Soft Loft Fusible Stabilizer](#)
- Tape
- 2—7” or longer nylon zippers (no metal zipper teeth, please!)
- 1—4” of fusible seam tape
- 2—2” pieces of grosgrain ribbon or nylon webbing for the strap loops
- 2—D Rings in the size of your choice—they should match the width of your strap. I used 1” D Rings. (Optional—you can attach the strap to the ribbon loops if you prefer)
- 2—D Rings with swivels (optional, but nice for changing or removing the strap)
- 1—Metal buckle with an adjustable slide (optional if you want an adjustable strap)
- Nylon webbing (or whatever fabric you prefer) for the strap
- Point Turner/Seam Creaser Tool
